## NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

**This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2009.**

**The NPS General Rules for Showing apply.**

**In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2008/2009 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2009 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.**

## P(UK) Qualifiers.

**This show is a qualifier for the 2009 Winter Championship Show. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each qualifying class will qualify. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of Ponies (UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid.**

**No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.**

**Competitors may enter either Northern, Southern or both winter championships.**

### **P(UK) KESTON ROYAL OCCASION M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Three Year olds qualifying before the 31st December 2008, will qualify for the Senior 4 years old and over Winter Championship of their Respective Breeds.**

3. Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C or D.
  4. Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Colt, Filly or Gelding, 2 or 3 years old. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C or D.
  5. Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, and Welsh Section A and B.
  6. Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C and D.
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify.**

### **P(UK) CONFINED NOVICE KESTON ROYAL OCCASION M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPS**

7. Mixed Mountain & Moorland In Hand Stallion, Colt, Filly, Mare or Gelding, any age. To be shown in hand. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B. NOT to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open mixed M&M In Hand classification before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
  8. Mixed Mountain & Moorland In Hand Stallion, Colt, Filly, Mare or Gelding, any age. To be shown in hand. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C or D. NOT to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open mixed M&M In Hand classification before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify**  
**IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 3-8 to compete)

### **P(UK) CHESHAM HANDLER CHAMPIONSHIP**

All handler classes are to be Judged on the handlers presentation and showing technique.

9. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms, to be led by a handler who has attained their 7th birthday but has not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
  10. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cms, to be led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify**

**Not before 12pm.**

**Clear Round jumping for 1 hour ONLY to commence after the judging of the above classes. First come first served.**

**£2.00 per round, pay at the ring. Please bring the correct money to the ring.**

11. **Leading Rein Jumping, to be judged over small course of coloured fences. Riders under 12yrs, ponies not to exceed 128cm. Jumps not to exceed 12". Rosettes to all. No individual show required, marks are taken from the jumping only.**
12. **Starter Combination of rider and pony starting out in jumping classes. Jumps to be 18" high. Any type. Rider and age. Rosette to all clear rounds. No individual show required, marks are taken from the jumping only.**
13. **Style and performance: Working Horse / Pony, maximum height of fences 61cm (2ft). No individual show required, marks are taken from the jumping only.**
14. **Style & Performance :Working Horse / Pony, maximum height of fences 76cms (2'6"). No individual show required, marks are taken from the jumping only.**

15. Unaffiliated First Ridden Class: Open to any breed, pony under 12.2hh. Walk and trot only First ridden, open to NOVICE Riders 11 yrs and under. Not to have one a first prize in any First ridden Class or Open class. This class is meant to give confidence to novice riders and must be entered into in the spirit in which it is intended. No cantering in the individual show.

**16. NPS M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) CONFINED NOVICE COLNE M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Leading Rein class.

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of the Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh section A & B studbooks. Not exceeding 122cms.

Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year). To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hand.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**17. NPS M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Waxwing Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland First Ridden Winter Championship**

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden class. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of the Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh section A & B studbooks. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

To be shown in any suitable bridle.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**Mini Novice Championship 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners from classes 16-17 to qualify.**

**18. NPS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Colne M&M Leading Rein Winter Championship**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of the Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh section A & B studbooks. Not exceeding 122cms.

Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year). To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hand.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**19. NPS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P(UK) Waxwing M&M First Ridden Winter Championship**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of the Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh section A & B studbooks. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**Open MINI CHAMPIONSHIP** (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 18-19 to compete)

*Commencing not before 12.30pm*

**20. NPS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds & P(UK) Llanarth M&M Open Ridden Winter Championship**

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Rider any age.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**21. NPS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds & P(UK) Llanarth M&M Open Ridden Winter Championship**

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Rider any age.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**Open RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP** (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prizewinners of classes 20 - 21 to compete)

**22. NPS M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds & P(UK) Confined Novice Llanarth M&M Ridden Winter Championship**

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle.

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Rider any age.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

**23. NPS M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds & P(UK) Confined Novice Llanarth M&M Ridden Winter Championship**

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Rider any age.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

Novice Ridden Championship 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners from Classes 22 - 23 to compete.

**24. *P(UK) Amateur Riders Ridden Mountain & Moorland Winter Championship.***

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over registered in the Pure Bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland & Welsh Sectins A, B, C & D. Riders any age.

***1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class to qualify***

***Rules Of Entry***

1. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury, damage or accident to any persons, animals, or property. It shall be deemed a condition of entry to the showground that all persons agree to indemnify the organisers and land owners against any legal action arising from any incident. All persons attending do so at their own risk.
2. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide any class should entries warrant.
3. The Appeal Committee's decision is final in any dispute. Objections must be made in writing within one hour of an incident and must be accompanied by a fee £20. This fee will be returned if the objection is upheld.
4. Correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. NB: A competitor whose hat comes off, or chinstrap comes undone whilst competing must, on penalty of elimination replace it or fasten it before continuing. The competitor may dismount without penalty to recover the hat or have it passed up from the ground, or may stop without penalty to fasten the chinstrap.
5. M&M breeds not to be shown with a plaited mane or tail except for the one long plait allowed in the WP&CS.
6. Ponies entered in any ridden class must be 4 years old or over.
7. No entry refunded, no substitution or nomination entry will be accepted.
8. No pony may be entered in a class that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his/her immediate family or employer.
9. Show organisers reserve the right to substitute a judge if necessary.
10. The Committee reserve the right to alter the wording of any class if the class wording is incorrect due to an error.
11. Any veterinary or farrier expenses incurred at the show are the responsibility of the owner of the horse or pony. We do have a Farrier on call.
12. It is strongly recommended that competitors have Public Liability Insurance.
13. The committee reserve the right to change the judges.
14. The judge's decision is final.
